<b>Except where specified, the entry in any class can be poetry, short story or prose, no longer than 250 words All work should be on A4 sheet with name on back of paper</b>	
701	A poem entitled "Disturbed Vision"
702	A piece of creative writing entitled "Out of Focus"
703	A Tanka entitled "Envisioning Home" <i>(A Tanka is a Japanese un-rhyming poem consisting of 31 syllables in 5 lines, with 5 syllables in the first and third lines and 7 in the others i.e. 5,7,5,7,7)</i>
704	A 50 word piece of poetry or prose entitled "I can see clearly now..."
705	<b>NOVICE CLASS:</b> Novice Class - Any piece of creative writing entitled "Our Vision for the Future" (A Novice is an entrant who has not previously won a prize in the Division G Section)

## DIVISION H – ART

**N.B.** Your entry must NOT have been exhibited in a previous Chalfont St Giles Show. Entries accepted from residents of the Parish of Chalfont St Giles and the surrounding area within a 20-mile radius. No entries after midnight 30<sup>th</sup> August 2020.

# How to upload your entries to PollUnit

Click on the relevant class name.

When it opens to the PollUnit click on “Add photo” on the left hand side of the page – this will open up a form

Add your name

Add your email address and make sure it's correct!

Click in the box that asks you to confirm it's your photo

Select and click on the photo you want to enter.

Make sure there is a unique name in the Image title box, this can be the file number.

Click to accept the Terms and Conditions

Click Save (you may have to scroll or arrow down to get to this button) and then receive a note to say thank you for your entry and an option to share the link. Please note: your photo won't appear until 1<sup>st</sup> September.
